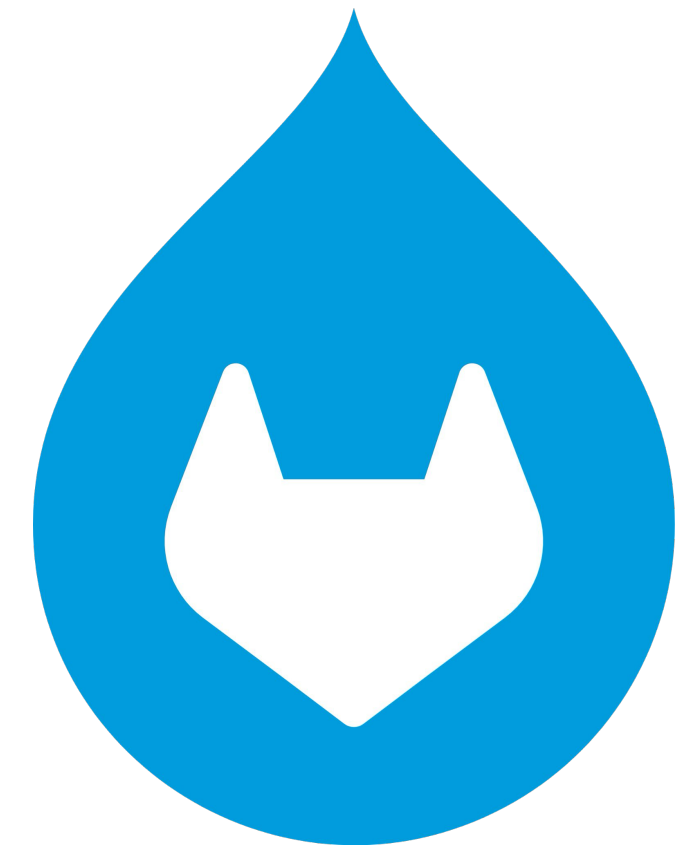

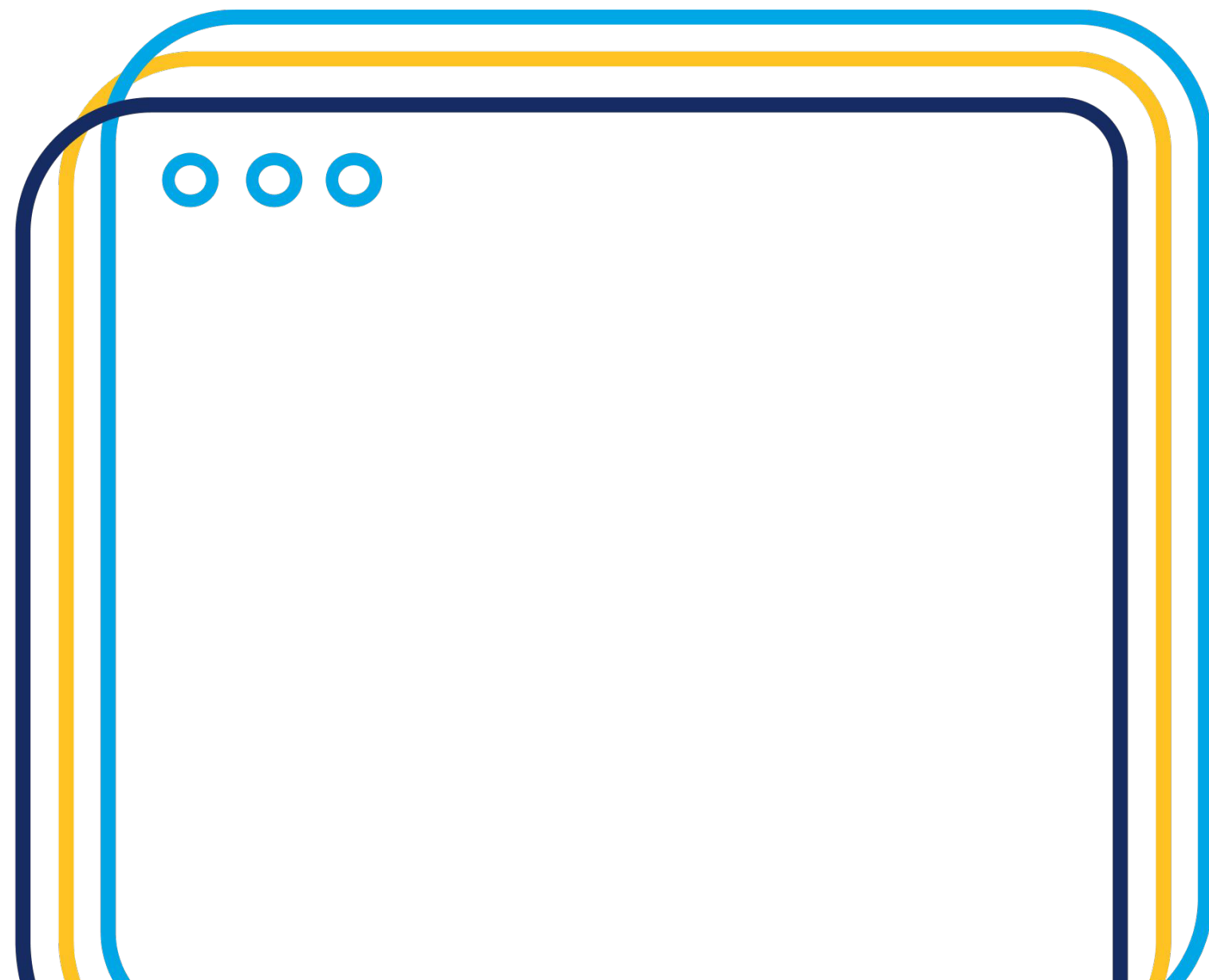



not just to use some tools.

Replace Bakery module with Keycloak
for single sign on, social sign-in, federated login,
and rebuild profile syncing around that



Preparing for issue migration

Decouple issues

Replace issue entity references with link fields

Audit for views, counting, anything that relies on issue nodes

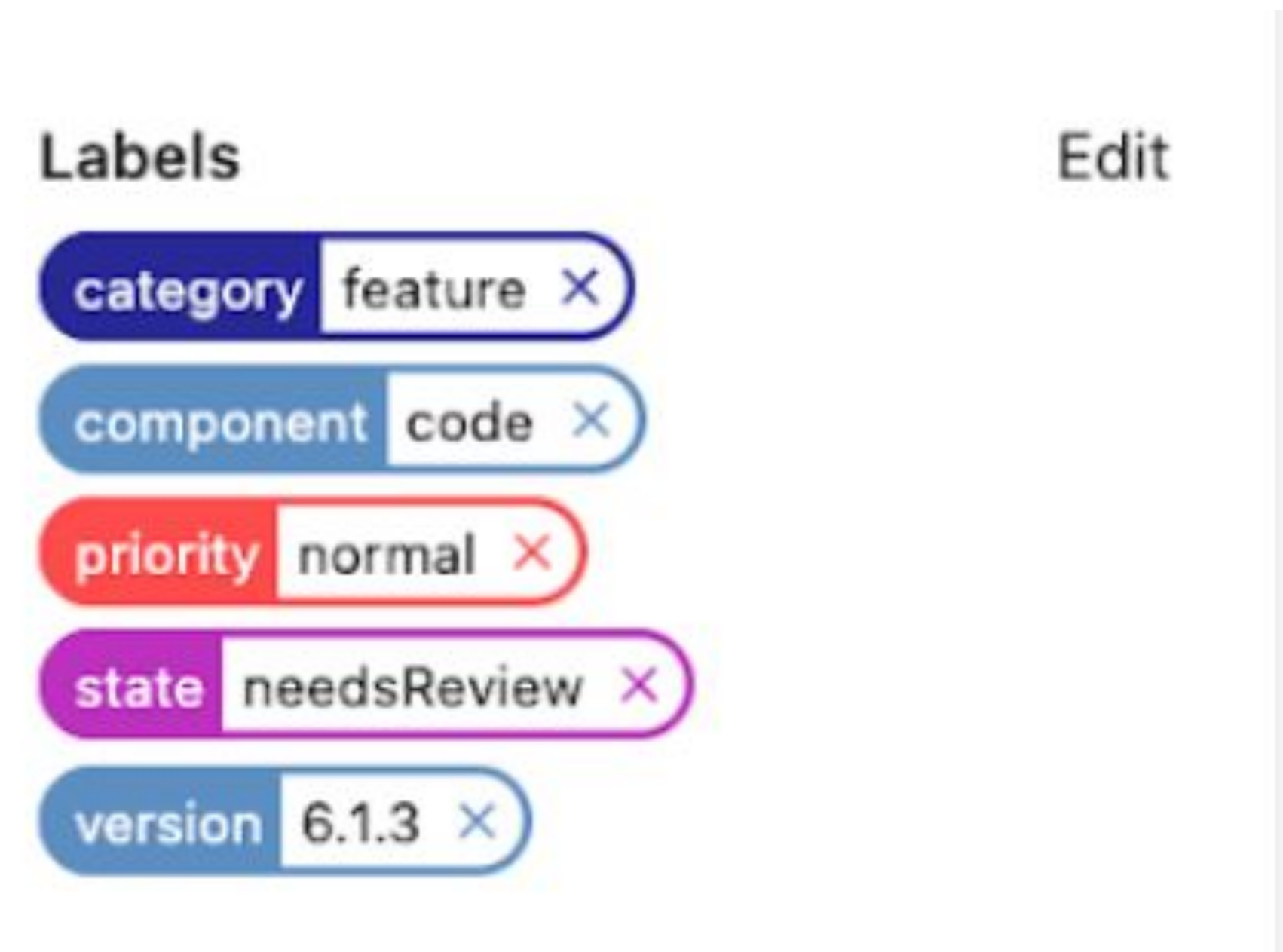

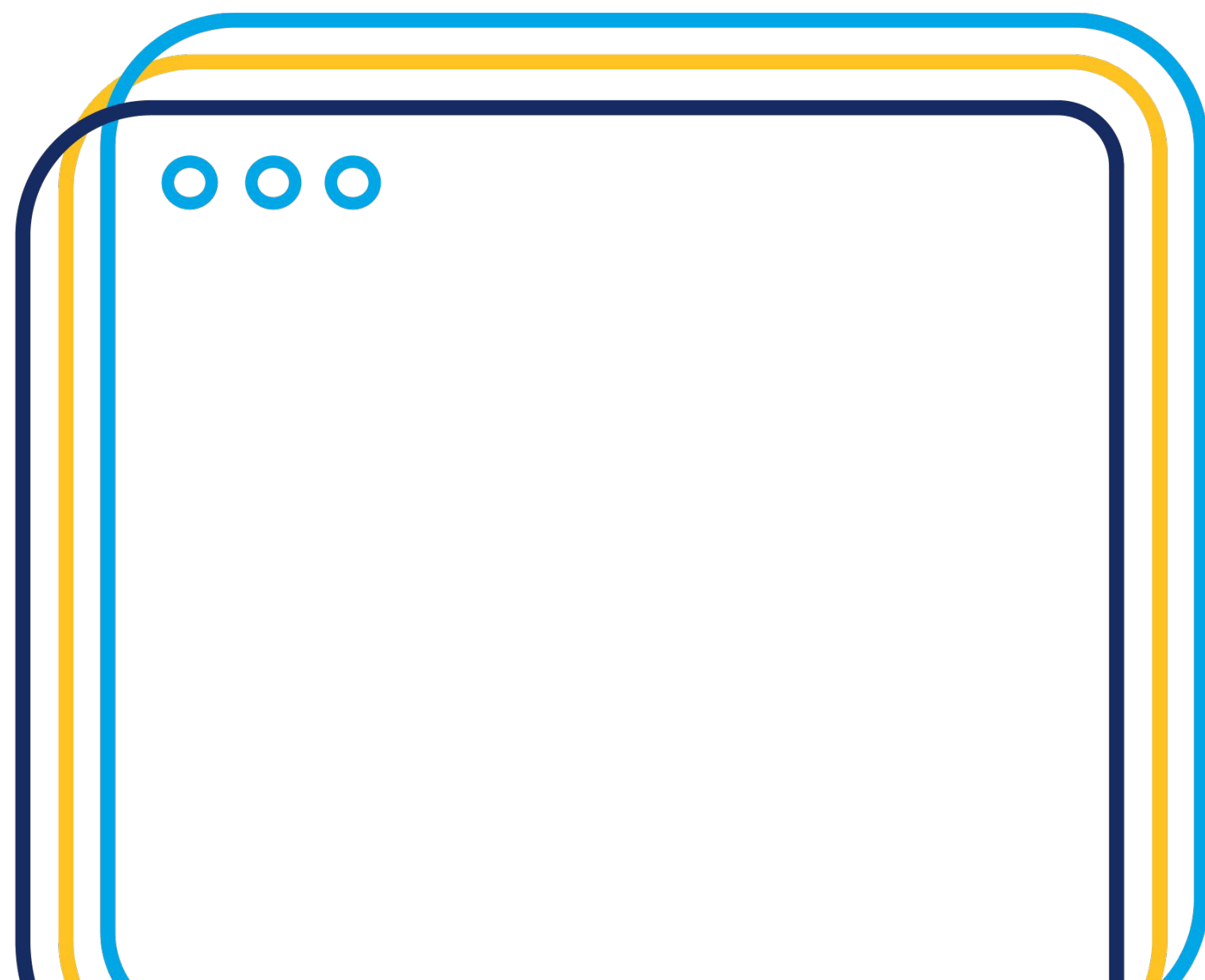
How you can help
